A preposition is a word or group of words that begins a prepositional phrase.

during	until
except	up
for	upon
from	with
in	without
in front of	within
inside	

* The prepositions *after*, *before*, and *since* may also function as subordinate conjunctions (AAAWWUBBIS signal words).
